Welcome back to what is always a long, but hectic half term. 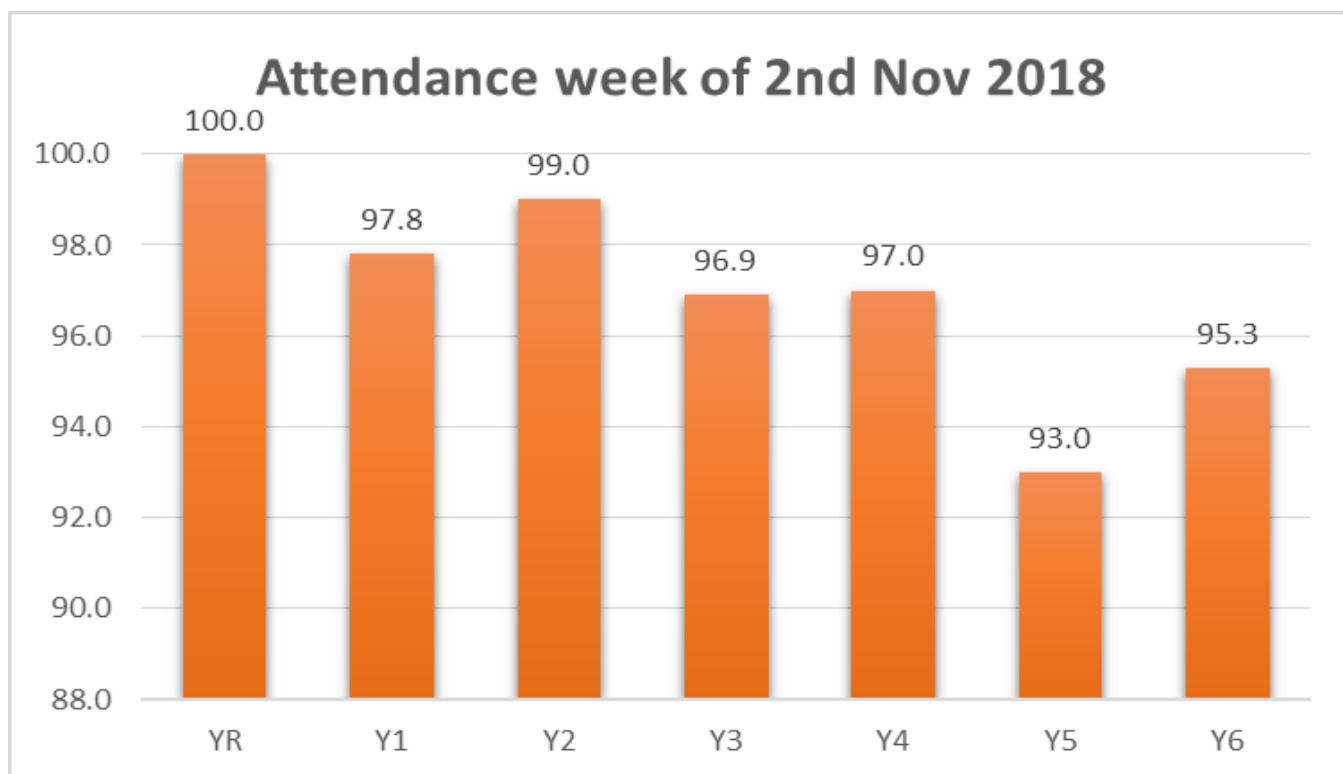
