Tuck shop available items no more than 50p and face painting for 50p.


This month's 100 club winner was number 56 Betty Kirk with £11 winnings. Loads of numbers still available if you want to join.

K52 children should have received their challenge award cards to be able to note down any activities they take part in so they can hopefully go on to achieve either Bronze, Silver or Gold award badges.
